

Freigefyhl releases first album

Pianist impresses with expressive melodies inspired by film musicians like Ludovico Einaudi

Bochum/Germany, 16 May 2023 – The German pianist and composer [Freigefyhl](#) released his first album: Since 12 May 2023 you can listen to 15 neoclassical piano pieces [on all streaming and download platforms](#). The debut album, called “Freigefyhl” as well, is inspired by his great film music idols [Ludovico Einaudi](#) (“The Intouchables”), [Yann Tiersen](#) (“The Fabulous Destiny of Amélie Poulain”) and [Joe Hisaishi](#) („Spirited Away”).

The album “Freigefyhl” is shaped by two topics: Love of nature and the emotional self-reflexion of the composer. The German musician lives in Bochum and is originally from Wolfsburg.

With the song “Cold Sun” Freigefyhl processed his existential fear as a full-time musician in the beginning of the Corona crisis, he got the idea for the song while he did a walk through fields and faced the cold march-sun. The piece “More Than Friends” addresses a complicated friendship, while the track “Nostalgia” is inspired by childhood memories. “Frozen Tears” is a tribute to a chapter in his life where he lived in Finland, overwhelmed by icy landscapes and Northern Lights. “Lunar Eclipse” captured the mood of the blood moon in Europe. “Summer Rain” is the very first composition of the 34 years old composer, which he composed when he was 17 and tried to handle his lovesickness. The single release “When The Wind Calls You” might especially appeal to anime fans: The song is inspired by the Japanese Joe Hisaishi, who is composing the soundtrack for all animes of [Studio Ghibli](#). The artist Freigefyhl has a passion for Ghibli movies, the most popular ones are “Spirited Away”, “Howl’s Moving Castle”, “Princess Mononoke” and “My Neighbor Totoro”. The single cover of Freigefyhl’s song is correspondingly designed in an anime style.

When you listen to Freigefyhl’s music you can tell that there is a strong influence of the Italian pianist Ludovico Einaudi. At least since the popular movie “The Intouchables”, for which the Italian composed the film music, Einaudi is well-known. Pieces like “Una Mattina”, “Nuvole Bianche” and “Experience” are very popular and help the Italian musician to fill stadiums on his concert tours.

The album “Freigefyhl” is indeed the first full-length album of the identically named composer and pianist, but he had his debut release already in 2015 with the EP “He Is Waiting...”, followed by several singles. In 2021 the pianist stroke a new path and looked for support of the professional [Martin Herzberg](#), one of Germany’s most popular neoclassical composers. Herzberg became his coach and mentor, together they worked out the right piano sound for Freigefyhl, which shaped his album.

Freigefyhl convinces with expressive melodies and an emotional flow. The music has a moody atmosphere and is mostly driven by topics like nature, nostalgia and melancholy. The artist’s name is German and has two meanings: The feeling of freedom as well as the freedom of emotions are reflected in the compositions of Freigefyhl. When you listen to his music, you dive into a world consisting only of your emotions. The neoclassical music genre, which classifies Freigefyhl’s work, is characterised by minimalistic modern elements as well as classical influences and can’t be imagined to be missing in the recent film music anymore.

The foundation of Freigefyhl’s music career was laid in 1994, when the artist was five years old. Back then he sat down at the antique piano of his grandmother and played familiar piano melodies by ear. In the following years several piano teachers helped him to improve his piano skills. In the age of 17 he discovered that he

could process his feelings through composing and touch other people with his music. Many years he was working on his music to finally use the chance in 2015 to record his first piano pieces in a recording studio.
